

Resolution 2009-30
Resolution to Award
Community Services Grants for 2009

WHEREAS, Monroe County government has for years supported and encouraged the work and goals of private community social service organizations by awarding them grant monies; and

WHEREAS, in 2008 the Monroe County Council assumed the duties and obligations of overseeing the awarding of community services grants from the Monroe County Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the Monroe County Council adopted Resolution 2008-51, "Resolution to Adopt Procedures for Awarding Community Services Grants" in September of 2008; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the guidelines of Resolution 2008-51, a grant application review committee for 2009, made up of three council members—Warren Henegar, Marty Hawk and Jill Lesh, and two private citizens of Monroe County—Barbara Lantz and Jason Carnes—was established to review applications for community services grant funds; and

WHEREAS, for 2009 the total amount budgeted for community services grants is \$95,000; and

WHEREAS, the Monroe County Council received 24 applications, requesting support in the amount of \$284,868.48; and

WHEREAS, the grant application review committee invited all applicants to appear at a public meeting and make presentations to the committee and the public via CATS, on September 24, 2009; and

WHEREAS, the grant application review committee, after hearing the presentations and further review of all applications, recommended to the full Council that the \$95,000 in the Community Services Grant line be awarded as per the breakdown shown in the list below; and

WHEREAS, based on grant committee rankings and recommendations in accordance with certain applicants' budgets, certain grants, listed below, are to be used for the specific enumerated purposes listed below, and all other grants are to be used for the general purposes outlined in the applications;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that:

The Monroe County Council total distribution of Community Services Grant Funds for 2009 shall be as follows:


