## Funding for Public Health Services

### Health Fund :

Taxes: \$274,209.66

*Note: December 2008 taxes were not received until January 2009*

Fees: \$360,020.73

Misc: 4,536.35

Grants: \$62,736.65

The health fund provides resources for public health services to the community such as identifying health hazards, investigating potential disease transmission and educating, developing policy, linking people to service.

Fifteen employees, the health office and health board are financially supported through the health fund. This allows the department to provide vital record information, perform inspections and investigations and educate the community, plus various other services in an effort to ensure the Indiana Code and local ordinances requirements are met for public health standards and to prevent disease. An STD and HIV grant is included in the health fund.

**Local Health Maintenance Fund:**  
\$54,504.00

The LHMF supplements the health fund by providing additional health services such as prenatal care for low-income women, vital record support, infectious disease follow-up and environmental health support. Two part-time positions are included in this fund.

**Tobacco Prevention:** \$50,941.36

Provides a Tobacco Cessation, Health educator to promote and provide tobacco cessation and education in an effort to reduce death associated with tobacco use and other health risks that contribute to chronic diseases.

**Title X:** \$193,956.57

This federal grant comes through the Indiana Family Health Council for reproductive health care and family planning for women. Services include pap smears, breast exams, pregnancy tests, STD screening and treatment, contraceptives, and education. Three full-time positions are included in this grant one of which

is shared by two individuals.

**Bio Terrorism:** \$ 42,758.76

Funding is provided from the state through Homeland Security and assists in the dept developing health emergency preparedness. This grant fund one full-time employee through August 9 of 2008. This total also includes funds received from a Medical Reserve Corp grant for emergency preparedness.
