TALK TO A CHILD

Young children notice and think about race. Adults often worry that talking about race will encourage racial bias in children, but the opposite is true. Silence about racism reinforces racism by allowing children to draw their own conclusions based on what they see. Here are a few examples of how to start a conversation and opportunities that could lead to a conversation about race with children.

TIPS TO GET YOU STARTED

- Understand that children notice difference
- Make space for your child's respectful curiosity
- Use age appropriate language
- Let your child see you face your own biases
- Acknowledge when you don't have a good answer
- Choose diversity (neighborhood, friends, activities)
- Tell stories of resistance, resilience, and joy
- Nurture critical race thinking
- Support your children to take a stand
- Plan for a marathon, not a sprint
- Fact check
