

#### WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

- ❖ Juveniles (under age 18) required to have parent/guardian ride along. IN211 will also provide rides home for parents/guardians if requested.

#### **HOW TO REQUEST A RIDE?**

- ➤ Dial 2-1-1.
- > Press 2 for English or 3 to for Spanish (other languages, press 2 and request a translator).
- ➤ Recorded message: "If you are calling for information about substance use treatment or transportation to and from treatment please press 9."
- > Press 9. Caller will be directed to speak with Lyft Community Navigator.



**SERVICES INCLUDE:** Parenting/Fathering; Communication; Relationships; Job training and readiness and Money Management


