COURT COSTS & FINES. Cash, money orders/cashier's checks, credit cards. **No personal checks.**

Probation Department Curry Building Office:

PROBATION & COMMUNITY CORRECTIONS FEES. Cash, money orders/cashier's checks, credit cards. **No personal checks.** When paying with cash, you must have **EXACT change**.

Community Corrections Office: CASH NOT ACCEPTED AT THIS OFFICE

Money orders and cashier's checks may be dropped off with Receptionist at Community Corrections.

Mail: DO NOT send cash. Send money orders or cashier's checks only.

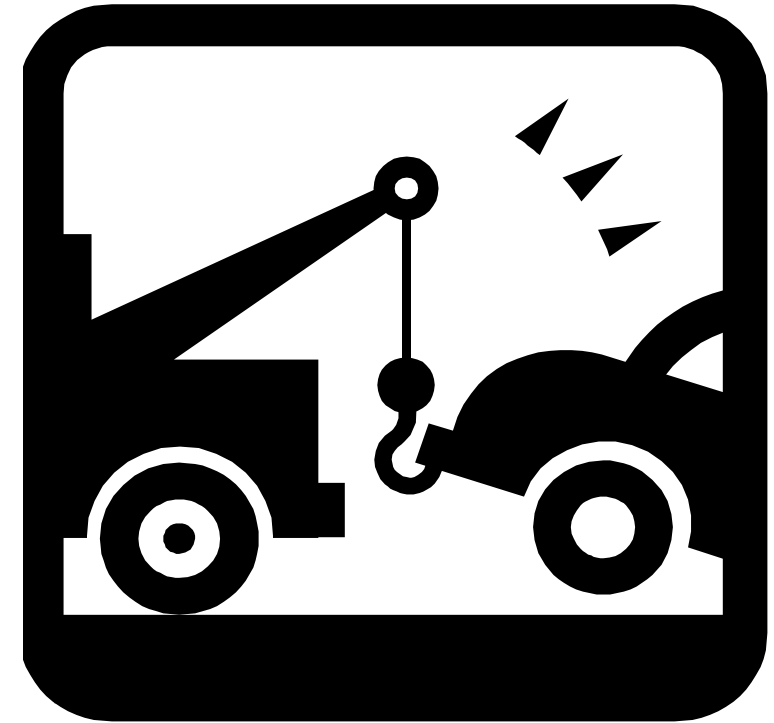

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

- ❖ Persons with current or past substance use disorder.
- ❖ Juveniles (under age 18) required to have parent/guardian ride along. IN211 will also provide rides home for parents/guardians if requested.

HOW TO REQUEST A RIDE?

- Dial 2-1-1.
- Press **2** for English or **3** to for Spanish (other languages, press 2 and request a translator).
- Recorded message: ***"If you are calling for information about substance use treatment or transportation to and from treatment please press 9."***
- Press **9**. Caller will be directed to speak with Lyft Community Navigator.

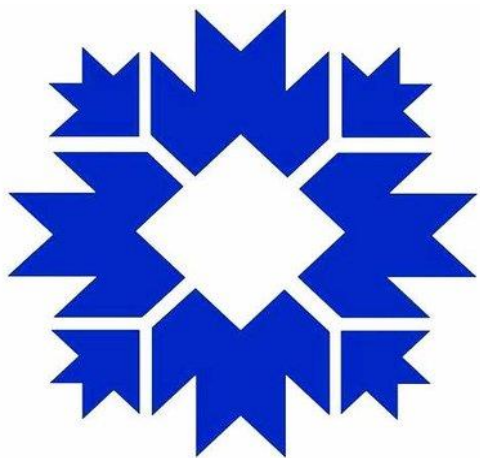

SERVICES INCLUDE: Parenting/Fathering; Communication; Relationships; Job training and readiness and Money Management

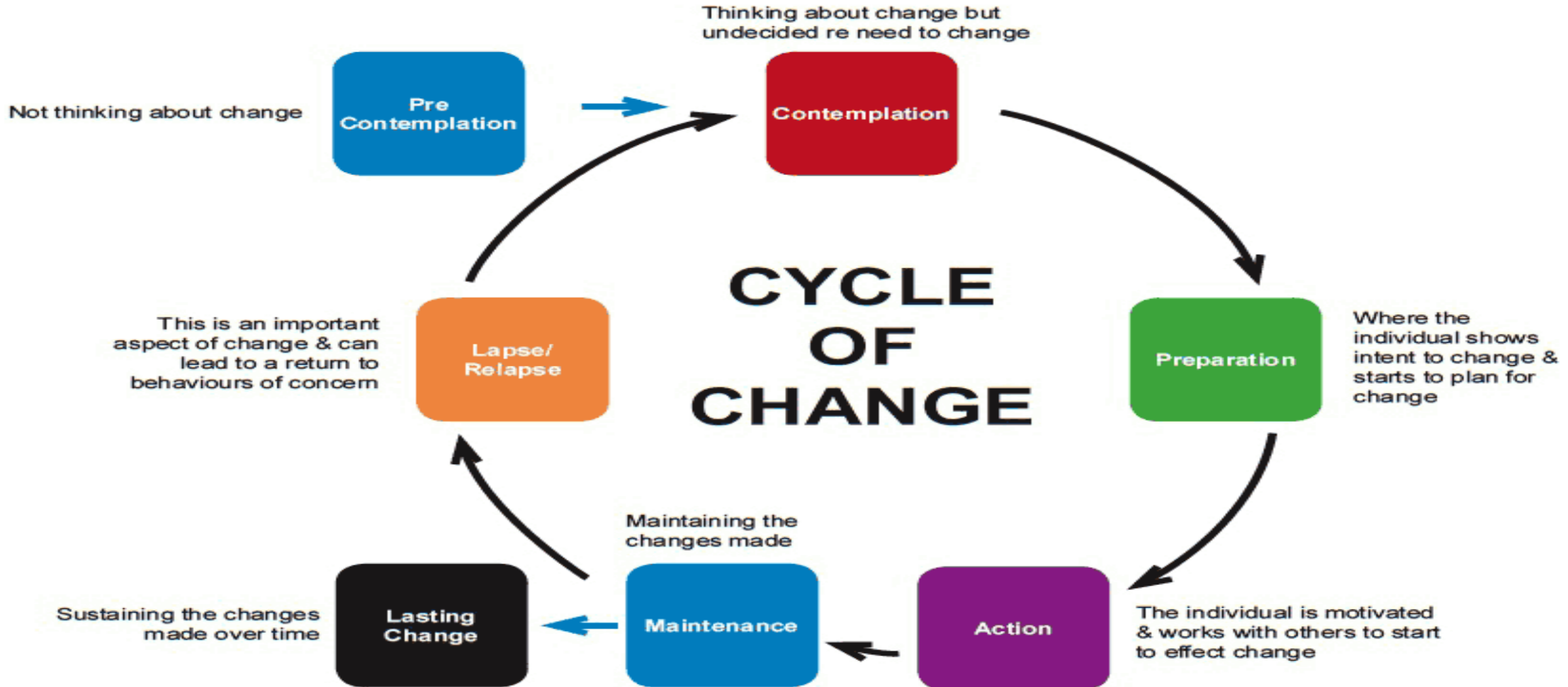
