A certificate of such police

delivered to the license administrator (Monroe County Building Commissioner).

Workmen's Compensation Insurance covering the personnel employed by death or injury arising out of operations being performed to the licensee. A certificate of such insurance shall be delivered to the license administrator (Monroe County Building Commissioner). Shall not apply if the licensee has no employees and gives appropriate notice to the Monroe County Licensing Board. The insurance notice both to the licensee and the Monroe County Licensing Board at least fifteen (15) days before such insurance is either cancelle renewed, and the certificate shall state this obligation.
