## Indiana Personal Property Online Portal Announcement

The State of Indiana has launched a <u>new online portal</u> for completing and submitting business personal property tax filings. The new Personal Property Online Portal for Indiana ("PPOP-IN") will allow taxpayers and their authorized agents to submit and review personal property tax filings in a single user-friendly web-based environment.

#### What is PPOP-IN?

The new, 24/7, self-service PPOP-IN portal will let taxpayers and authorized agents file Forms 102, 103-Short, 103-Long, 103-N, 103-O, 104, and 106 online. Taxpayers will also have the ability to upload additional personal property forms and any necessary supporting documentation.
