Position Title:	Disease Intervention Specialist (DIS)
Position Summary:	Incumbent serves as Disease Intervention Specialist for the Health Department, responsible for monitoring, interviewing, linking to treatment, and preventing sexually transmitted diseases (STDs) in a 12 county area. This is a grant position.
Job Responsibilities:	<p>A Disease Intervention Specialist (DIS) is an investigator that intervenes in the spread of Sexually Transmitted Diseases (STDs). DIS investigates reported, suspected and potential cases of STDs.</p> <p>A typical day may include conversations with healthcare providers & clients with known infections, confirming treatment and partner referrals. It may include contacting clients who may be unaware of an infection. Other duties may include data entry, grant application preparation, and accreditation activities. Routine travel within 12 county jurisdiction required.</p>
Qualifications:	Baccalaureate Degree in public health, health education, biological sciences, or related field. Possession of and ability to retain possession of required certifications, including disease intervention specialist training, HIV testing and counseling certification, phlebotomy skills and National Incident Management System (NIMS) certification, and a valid driver's license.
