Uses data collected to determine classification and suitability for wastewater disposal.</p> <p>Evaluates sites or property for a suitable location for wastewater disposal, including determining slope, lay, and condition of the site, and analyzing the amount of wastewater that may be generated by proposed domiciles or commercial enterprise. Consults often with Wastewater Sanitarians, local officials, and the public.</p>
Qualifications:	<p>BA in Agronomy, Soil Sciences, Geology, Public or Environmental Health, or a related field. Experience preferred. Must be in possession of State Certification as a Soil Scientist. Proficient in Microsoft Office programs (Word, Excel, Access, Outlook, PowerPoint) and ArcGIS.
