with Elected and Appointed Officials

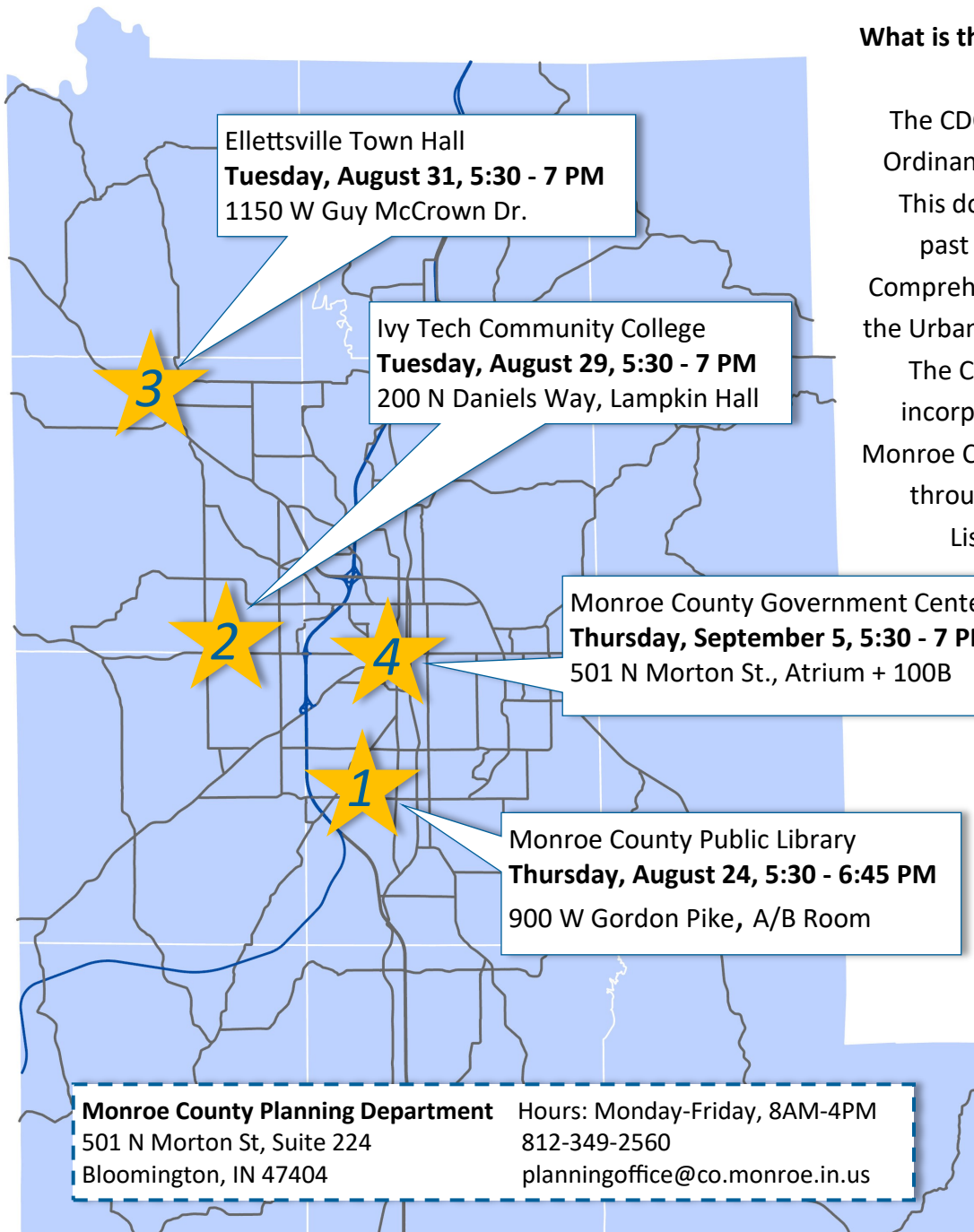


Starting August 24th, the Monroe County Planning Department will host four listening sessions for Monroe County citizens to speak in-person or virtually with their County representatives about the zoning of property within Monroe County Zoning Jurisdiction.

Planning Staff will be available to determine citizens' proposed zoning districts, and identify how the change may affect the "Permitted and/or Conditional" uses in that district.

What is the County Development Ordinance?

The CDO is the future Zoning Ordinance of Monroe County. This document is guided by past studies such as the Comprehensive Plan (2012), and the Urbanizing Area Plans (2016). The CDO and past studies incorporate feedback from Monroe County Citizens collected through events like these Listening Sessions.
